

Note: We have hired a new landscaper for the front entrance to reduce our fees. They mow every other week. They trimmed the trees and bushes last month.

Enforcement: Several homeowner's have asked why HOA rules are not being enforced. The simple reason is that we have not been organized until now. If you feel something should be reported please contact the HOA above.

Dues: We currently pay \$150/yr per lot. This is not sufficient in order to effectively manage the HOA. The dues will be increased in the near future once a budget has been approved.
